MESSAGE OUTLINE

Let Us Draw Near

"Let us draw near to God ... Let us hold unswervingly to the hope... Let us consider how we may spur one another ... Let us not give up meeting together..." Heb. 10:19-25, NIV

I. "Am I _____?" {vs 22}

"...let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith..." "Wash me!" was the anguished prayer of King David in Psalm 51... "Wash!" was the message of John the Baptist... "Unless I wash you, you have no part with me," said the towel-draped Jesus to Peter. Without our being washed clean...

II. "Am I _____?" {vs 23}

"...Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess," Or this way, "Let's keep a firm grip on the promises that keep us going. He always keeps his word." (The Message)

III. "Is there a _____?" {vs 24, 25}

"...And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together..." People need people. This connection over "communion" (which, by the way, is another word for coming together) is us declaring to each other that we are in this together, remembering what God has done through Christ.

Breadlife: We are headed to the Littleton Church of Christ for a Devo hosted by Breadlife. With roots from Pepperdine, Breadlife provides ovens to cook bread for villages in East Africa and train people to use them so that they can provide for some of their own needs. Departure is 6:00 pm and estimated return is 9:15 pm. Eat before you come.

Camp on the Reservation: June 25-July 2. Limited to 14 spots. We are headed to Arizona to be involved in a camp which targets Native Americans as participants. This is a primitive camp that offers a cross-cultural experience. During the Sunday through Wednesday session participants will sleep in tents, use natural bathroom facilities (shovel) and find out what four days with no shower is like. \$40 Due June 20.

Urban Outreach: July 10-17 in North Little Rock, Arkansas. A work camp designed to help elderly struggling to keep up with the demands of today's economy. During this trip we will visit the campuses of Oklahoma Christian and Harding University as well as have a time of water oriented recreation before returning. \$40 Due July 4.

Warehouse Wednesday: On these nights we will meet in "The Warehouse" at 6:30 for a campus located event. We may have a Devo or we may have some type of activity. Regardless we will end at 7:30.

\$5 Fun Night: Just what it says. Takes place periodically during the summer on Wednesdays at off campus locations. Meet at Eastside at 6:30 and pick up at the announced location of our activity at 8:30.
