SERMON NOTES

Why Character Matters: A Response To What God Has Done

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. (2 Peter 1:3, NIV)

What path must I take to know the benefits associated with developing Christ-like character?

1. It begins when I develop (vs.3)

This knowledge is possible because . . .

A. **The Grace of God.** "it is by grace you have been saved." Eph. 2:5

B. **The Goodness of God.** "by His own glory and goodness." (vs.3)

C. **The Gift of God.** Faith that is ours is something we have "received."

2. It continues through (vs.4)

"To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:32 (NIV)

3. It leads to real (vs.4)

"When you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit." Ephesians 1:13 (NLT)

"Since, then, we do not have the excuse of ignorance, everything--and I do mean everything--connected with that old way of life has to go. It's rotten through and through. Get rid of it! And then take on an entirely new way of life--a God-fashioned life, a life renewed from the inside and working itself into your conduct as God accurately reproduces his character in you."
