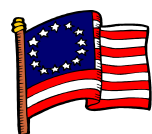

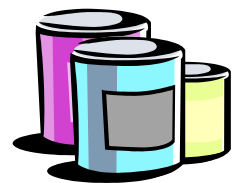
CONGRATULATIONS
