SERMON NOTES

Close Encounters With God: God Calls Ordinary People

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, **obeyed and went**, even though he did not know where he was going. (Heb.11:8, NIV)

1. **Abraham, Called to go.** _____
"All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring forever. I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that if anyone could count the dust, then your offspring could be counted. Go, walk through the length and breadth of the land, for I am giving it to you." (Gen.13:15-17, NIV)

2. **Abraham, the Father of the** _____.

He didn't **OBEY** totally (Gen. 12:1, 4-5)
He, gulp, **LAUGHED** at God (Gen. 17:16-17)
He couldn't **WAIT**. (Gen 16:1-4)
He called his **WIFE** his **SISTER!** (Gen. 12:17-20)
He was **COMMENDED** for his faith, but never "saw" what he was looking for. (Heb. 11:10, 39)

3. **Abraham, faithful with what he was given to do;** _____.

Abraham's story is our story. In the beginning of this relationship, we can see a reflection of the beginning of our relationship with God as well. It begins with a promise, unconditional and unmerited, with God seeking us first before we even are aware God is there, and the fulfillment of the promise in Jesus Christ for our salvation - our hope - our future. **God calls ordinary people.**
