SERMON NOTES

Close Encounters With God: The Wrestler

*Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, because you have struggled with God and with men and have overcome."
(Gen. 32:28, NIV)*

#1 -- Get Alone with God

So Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him till daybreak. (Gen.32:24)

#2 -- Get Bold but still Authentic With God

What's authentic about you today? Is it an authentic relationship with an Almighty God? So honest and open that you will not settle for anything less than Him.

#3 -- Get Cleaned Up By God

Then the man said, "Let me go, for it is daybreak." But Jacob replied, "I will not let you go unless you bless me. The man asked him, "What is your name?" "Jacob," he answered. Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, because you have struggled with God and with men and have overcome." (Gen 32:26-28 NIV)

Wrestle with God – just do it! You'll walk away with a new identity, a new walk (a limp) and a new relationship that will empower you.
