SERMON NOTES

Close Encounters With God: Yes You Can!

But Moses said to God, "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" And God said, "I will be with you."
(Ex.3:11-12, NIV)

Moses is like so many of us. He's plagued with self doubt, fear, and a sense of inadequacy. But God deals patiently with him, just as he does with us, until Moses agrees to do what God asks. And then begins the training...

1. Israel's Need - God's Concern

The LORD said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them..."
(Ex. 3:7-8a)

2. Self Doubt - God's Presence and God's Name

God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you.'" (Ex.3:14)

3. Fear of Rejection and Failure - God's Power

Then the LORD said to him, "What is that in your hand?" (Ex.4:2)

A Sense of Inadequacy - God's Help Comes...

Now go; I will help you speak and will teach you what to say." (Ex.4:12)
